Dear Families,

Welcome to the Overlea-Fullerton Recreation Council's Dance Program. We want you and your child to have a wonderful experience, so we ask you to do the following:

- 1. Have your child appropriately dressed in <u>dance attire</u> with hair out of face, <u>pink</u> <u>ballet shoes</u>, <u>black tap shoes</u> (speak to your teacher about what type), <u>black jazz shoes</u>, and <u>black sneakers</u> for hip hop.
- 2. <u>DO NOT</u> leave your child unattended. If your child arrives before the start of class, there is <u>no one</u> supervising your child until class begins. Your child is to be picked up promptly at the end of class.
- 3. Parents who bring small children into the building are responsible for supervising them. For their safety, children must remain with their parents or guardians at all times and must be present while students are in class. No one is allowed to wander through the school halls, rooms, lockers, etc.
- 4. No running, ball-playing, or roughhousing is allowed in the hallways or rooms. Children are not allowed to bring or use balls or sports equipment in the building.
- 5. Please have respect for all items on the walls and doors. Do not touch, remove, or tear anything. Also, please have respect for the bathrooms.
- 6. NO SMOKING is allowed anywhere in the school building or on school grounds.
- 7. Please remember... We are guests in the school building!
- 8. Costume Deposit is due before Wednesday, November 22, 2023, before Thanksgiving.
- 9. The remaining cost for the costume will be charged on your Stone Alley account in January 2024 and due Friday, April 5, 2024.
- 10. We will hold a stage rehearsal tentatively on Tuesday, March 26, 2024.
- 11. <u>Tentative</u> Dress Rehearsals and Recitals are Saturday, May 4, 2024 and Sunday, May 5, 2024. Dress Rehearsal is <u>MANDATORY</u> in order to perform in the Recital. Children must attend and participate in at least 20 classes to perform in the Recital.
